

■ Letter to Representative: Protect Medicaid

Subject: Stop the Plan to Abolish Medicaid—This Is a Matter of Life and Death

Dear [Representative/Senator] [Last Name],

I am writing in urgent protest of any efforts to abolish Medicaid—a program that millions of Americans, including my own family, rely on for basic survival. My [relation], who is physically disabled and fully immobile, receives life-sustaining care in a nursing facility through Medicaid. To destroy Medicaid is to sign a death sentence for elderly patients, people with disabilities, children with complex medical needs, and low-income adults who depend on it for treatment, medicine, and care. This is not fiscal responsibility. It is moral failure.

I am deeply disturbed by the silence or complicity of elected officials who were sent to Washington to represent their constituents—not abandon them. Voters across party lines recognize the value of Medicaid. You should be very concerned about the political consequences of siding with an agenda that bulldozes the social contract we all depend on.
